

GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. There will be no team movement between division zero and one for 3rd, 4th and 5th grade brackets. In other words, division zero teams will remain the same for the tournament.
2. The tournament format is not single or double elimination. However, each team is guaranteed with two games as a minimum. There is no consolation bracket and only two teams will be advanced to the championship game.
3. 2nd/3rd grade games will be on Friday evening and 4th/5th grade games will be on Saturday for the first two rounds.
4. 5th grade both divisions and 4th grade division zero championship games are on 02/16/10 (Tuesday) evening at DU Magness Arena.
5. 2nd and 3rd grade championship games are on 02/20/10 (Saturday) at DU Hamilton.
6. 4th grade division one championship game is on 02/20/10 (Saturday) at DU Hamilton.
7. For 3rd, 4th and 5th Grade Division One with multiple groups, teams will be combined and only one championship game will be offered for each division one bracket.
8. Teams will be seeded according to the final regular season standings. The following tie-breakers will be used to seed teams:
 - Head to head competition
 - Result of games against common opponents
 - Winning percentage
 - Coin flip

2nd Grade - All 21 teams will be combined and seeded based on the final standings. The top seven (7) teams will be assigned to group A and the remaining teams will be placed in group B. There will be one championship game for each group for 2nd grade.

3rd Grade Division Zero – 8 teams tournament bracket.

3rd Grade Division One – 18 teams will be combined and seeded based on the final standings.

4th Grade Division Zero - 10 teams tournament bracket.

4th Grade Division One - 23 teams will be combined and seeded based on the final standings.

5th Grade Division Zero – 8 teams tournament bracket.

5th Grade Division One - 18 teams will be combined and seeded based on the final standings.
