

AYL FOOTBALL COMMUNICATIONS/COMPLAINT PROCESS

In an effort to improve the timeliness and quality of communications from Coaches and Parents regarding AYL Football the Football Board has developed this memo to clarify the Football communication/complaint process.

When Parents or coaches have issues of any nature regarding football the most effective contact for those issues is through each AYL Club's Football Delegate. If issues relate to playing time, performance of your Coach, Club fees, etc. these are directly related to the operation of the individual Club and thus are better addressed directly by that Club. Your Football Delegate is the most effective person to get these types of issues addressed within your Club. If issues relate to schedules, scores/standings, opposing coach behavior, league rules, performance of officials, playoffs, etc. these are AYL league wide issues and are best addressed by the AYL Football Board. Your Club Delegate is your Club's representative that sits on the AYL Football Board that meets every week during the season. This weekly meeting includes all Clubs' Delegates, the Head Official, our league Scheduler, as well as other support people associated with the management of this Football Board. The weekly Board meetings are managed by our AYL Football VP and are intended to resolve any league issues in a timely manner. One major responsibility of the AYL Football Board is to ensure that all Clubs are operating their football teams in accordance with our league wide AYL Rules as well as our AYL Football Code of Conduct. By communicating your concerns to your Club Delegate you are providing this individual with very important details that are required to correctly and rapidly solve these league wide issues.
